1. Approval of the Minutes:

2. Friends Report:

The Friends sold 30 pairs of earrings made by Council member, Paula Moore. They cancelled the Car Show this year and are considering doing it next year. The Country Fair will be held on November 18 from 10am-3pm at the Senior Center.

Salary increases went into effective July 1 and Kendra is still looking to recruit 2-4 more drivers.

6. Old/New Business and Community Awareness:


our November board meeting.

The search for a new Town Administrator continues with the search firm hired for the first search at no additional cost to the town. Candidates are being sourced and screened.
