COVID-19 Quarantine Guidance for <u>Daycares</u>:

Exposed to someone with COVID-19



Exempt from quarantine:

*Up to date on vaccination and asymptomatic Had Covid in the past 90 days *Up-to-date" on COVID-19 vaccination is defined as:

- Completed primary series of Pfizer, Moderna, or J&J vaccine AND a booster
 - OR
- Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine with the last 5 months
 - OR
- Received J&J vaccine within the last 2 months

If not, the individual should stay home for 5 days (after exposure)

If the individual can mask:

Return back to care on Day 6 (after exposure) and remain asymptomatic

(test recommended on day 5, but not required)

Wear a well-fitted mask through Day 10

If the individual cannot mask: (including ages birth to 2)

If individuals can test on day 5:

When test negative and remain asymptomatic, individual can return back to care the day after a negative test (rapid test for ages 2+) returning to care no later than day 11

If individuals cannot test:
Stay home for 10 days,
return to daycare on day 11

If symptoms develop, get a test and stay home.

Antigen tests (at home tests) are authorized for individuals two years of age or older.

COVID-9 Isolation Guidelines for the <u>Daycares</u>:

You need to stay home if you have:

New cough
Fever 100.0F or higher/chills
Shortness of breath
New loss of taste or smell
Muscle or body aches

Nausea/vomiting/diarrhea*
Sore throat*
Headache*
Congestion/runny nose*
Fatigue*

*In combination with listed symptoms

If an individual tests positive for COVID-19, they should stay home for a minimum of 5 days.

(Day 0 is date or positive test or onset of symptoms)

If the individual can mask:
(2+ years old)

Symptoms subsiding and fever-free without medication for 24 hours students can return to care on day 6 (test recommended on day 5, but not required)

Wear a well-fitted mask through Day 10 when around others

Partnership for Health

If the individual cannot mask: (Birth-2 years old)

Symptoms must be subsiding and be fever-free without medication for 24 hours.

If individuals can test on day 5 or later:
When test negative, individuals can
go back to care (rapid test for ages 2+)
returning to care no later than day 11

If individuals cannot test:
Stay home for 10 days,
return to daycare on day 11.
