1. Call to order, roll call
2. Approve minutes of May 19, 2021 Zoom meeting
3. Treasurer presents update on EDTF financial balances
4. Review current EDTF application criteria, as guided by MGL Chapter 60 § 3D –
 - a. You must own and occupy your residence in Northborough for at least the past five consecutive years
 - b. You or your spouse must be at least 60 years of age by January 1, 2021 *or* have a “state-recognized disability”
 - c. Income cannot exceed \$29,500 per year for individual; \$45,000 per year for total household
 - d. The assessed value of your home cannot exceed \$496,961 (this amount matches the Town's annual average single family home assessment).
5. Any other business that may legally come before the Committee
6. Enter Executive Session – pursuant to MGL Chapter 30A, § 21, Subsection 7 – to comply with, or act under the authority of, any general or special law or federal grant-in-aid requirements – to consider aid applications pursuant to MGL Chapter 60, Section 3D
