There will be a meeting of the **Northborough Conservation Commission on Monday, July 8, 2024, at 6:00 pm.**

Pursuant to Chapter 2 of the Acts of 2023, An Act Relative to Extending Certain COVID-19 Measures Adopted During the State of Emergency, signed into law on March 29, 2023, this meeting will be conducted via remote participation. No in-person attendance by members or the public will be permitted. The meeting will include the following hearings pursuant to MGL Chapter 131, Section 40, the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act, the Northborough Wetlands Protection Bylaw, and/or the Northborough Stormwater Management and Land Disturbance Bylaw:

Request for Determination of Applicability: 17 Coolidge Circle (Map/Parcel 14/58) owned by Lisa and James Stone to remove 11 trees and resurface the existing driveway. The work is proposed within the Bordering Vegetated Wetland, the 25' No Disturb Zone, the 35' No Structures Zone, and the 100' Wetland Buffer Zone.

Request for an Extension of an Order of Conditions: 95 and 105 Lincoln Street (Map/Parcels 62/4 & 8) owned by Leandro Siqueira and Silvio DeOliveira to extend the time for completion of the approved property improvements. The work will not alter any new areas on the lots.
